In view of the provisions of section 9 sub section 3 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. Act No. XXVIII of 2015) published on 17th August 2015, the Pravesh Niyantran Samiti existing as on the date of commencement of the Act shall continue to exercise the powers of Admissions Regulating Authority till such Authority is duly constituted under the Act.

Part - I (Medical Education)

Attention of the Authority is drawn to Chapter III, Section 9, subsection (5), clause (iii) of the Government of Maharashtra in Act No. XXVIII of 2015.

After deliberations, the Authority directs to the Guardian College of Dental Sciences and Research Center, Thane to produce the copy of the petition as earlier directed by the Authority in its meeting held on 18th December 2015. Otherwise no action can be taken. Office of the Authority to inform accordingly.

The Authority directs the captioned College to act as per the provisions of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulations of Admissions and fees) Act, 2015 (Mah Act No. XXVIII of 2015) which clarifies the meaning of Common Entrance Test (CET) and Centralized Admission Process (CAP). There is no mention of college CET in the Act. This Authority is for the compliance of relevant provisions of the Act and to supervise admissions done through the State CET-CELL. Hence there will be no any college CET. Therefore colleges should not write to the Authority for such type of permissions. Office to inform accordingly.


