

Minutes of Meeting of the **Pravesh Niyran Samiti (Higher and Technical Education)** held under the Chairmanship of **Justice D.K. Deshmukh (Retd.)** on Tuesday, the **11th August, 2015 at 2.30 p.m.** in the Conference Hall, Office of the Regional Centre, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, 4th Floor, Government Dental College Building, St. Georges Hospital Campus, Near CST, Fort, Mumbai – 400 001.

However Mrs. K.V. Sane, Desk Officer, Pravesh Niyran Samiti, Mumbai represented the office of Pravesh Niyran Samiti, Mumbai. Shri. N. K. Deshmukh, I.A.S. Office Secretary (holding Additional Charge) Pravesh Niyran Samiti, Mumbai was not present in the meeting, though agenda of the meeting is signed by him as office secretary; Samiti has resolved to sought the interaction of Principal Secretary and also of general administration department for ensuring his attendance in the meeting of the Samiti. Today Samiti again resolves as above.

Copies of Agenda along with copies of relevant documents were circulated to the Members.

Item No.1: To approve and confirm the Minutes of the Meeting of Pravesh Niyran Samiti (Higher & Technical Education) held on Friday, the 17th July 2015 at Regional Office of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Mumbai.

Minutes of Meeting of Pravesh Niyran Samiti (Higher & Technical Education) held on Friday, the 17th July 2015 in Conference Hall, Office of the Regional Centre, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, 4th Floor, Government Dental College Building, St. Georges Hospital Campus, Near CST, Fort, Mumbai – 400 001 are approved and confirmed, subject to following modifications/corrections.

I) Item no. 5 (b), (c), (d) and (e) to be read as under:

"Samiti carefully went through the contents of Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and fees) ordinance published on 12-5-2015. Samiti also went through an order for removal of difficulties issued under section 25. Respective samiti's have been accordingly authorized to discharge their functions under sections 9 and 13. In light of these provisions; Samiti after deliberations comes to the conclusion that it was beyond the competence of the Samiti to grant or refuse permissions to hold CETs followed by CAP admissions process being conducted by various associations of colleges. However Samiti feels it proper to seek guidance / response from Government.

Samiti therefore directs the office of Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, to send a communication to Government through Principle Secretary, Higher and Technical Education Dept, M.S. and Principle Secretary Medical Education and Drugs Department, asking therein the guidance/response from state Government as to whether the Samiti should proceed to decide as to giving permissions or refusing permissions to hold CETs to be followed by CAP by the respective associations for the Academic Year 2015-16 as was previously being done by the Samiti, Samiti feels that such a permission can not be granted by Samiti at this juncture, when the Ordinance dated 12th May 2015 has come into force with immediate effects from the date of publication in the official Government Gazette.

It is further resolved to seek the response from the Government as to whether the CET's conducted by respective directorates of Government after 12th May 2015 shall be treated as valid or not in so far admissions to Private Unaided Colleges are concerned.

After receipt of the response from the Government of Maharashtra Items no. 5 (b), (c), (d) and (e) should be placed before the Samiti in next Meeting. Office to communicate."

"Samiti carefully went through the contents of Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and fees) ordinance published on 12-5-2015. Samiti also went through an order for removal of difficulties issued under section 25. Respective samiti's have been accordingly authorized to discharge their functions under sections 9 and 13. 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2015-16 as was preciously being done by the Samiti or not; Samiti fees that such a permission can not be granted by Samiti at this juncture, when the Ordinance dated 12th May 2015 has come into force with immediate effects from the date of publication in the official Government Gazette.

It is further resolved to seek the response from the Government as to whether the CET's conducted by respective directorate of Government after 12th May 2015 shall be treated as valid or not in so far admissions to Private Unaided Colleges are concerned.

After receipt of the response from the Government of Maharashtra above Item no. 5 (b), (c), (d) and (e) should be take place before the Samiti in next Meeting. Office to communicate. "

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Item No. 3: **Letter dated 3rd August 2015 received from Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 17th July 2015 regarding Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Ordinance published on 12th May 2015.**

Samiti perused the Letter under reference received from Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 17th July 2015 regarding Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and fees) Ordinance published on 12th May 2015. Noted, Samiti though differs with the interpretation by the Government as quoted in Para 2(2) and 2(3) of the letter under reference, Samiti notes the intention of the Government for redressal of the difficulties if any behind the citations in aforesaid paragraphs.

Item No. 4 : **To discuss and decide on the Letters / representations received from Associations:- (Ref. Minutes of the Meeting held on 17th July 2015.)**

Item No. 4 (a): **Letter dated 18th June 2015 received from Director, Higher Education, Pune submitting their remarks on Draft Boucher of B.Ed./M.Ed. Asso – CET 2015-16 [Ref. Minutes of Meeting held on 30th April 2015 Item no. 5 (a)]**

- 1) Samiti perused the remarks of Expert Committee i.e. Director, Higher Education, Pune appointed by the Samiti; vide letter no. उंशिसं/२०१४-१५/प्रनिस/नियमावलीतपासणी/बीएड दि. १८/६/२०१५ Samiti also perused various letters as quoted hereunder___
 - i) Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Pune has submitted Letter dated 5/3/2015 signed by Prof. Gajendra Ainapure regarding nomination of competent authority to conduct CET/ CAP 2015 for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses and Draft Information brochure of CET/CAP 2015. Dr. Santuk Hambarde has been appointed as a Competent Authority.
 - ii) Dr. Shaikh Ramzan, Secretary Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Pune has submitted his objection to above proposal to conduct CET/CAP 2015.
- 2) Samiti in its Meeting held on 27th March 2015 vide Item no. 4 (a) and (b) decided as under___

"Samiti perused the letters under reference. Samiti observed that there are two different letters from two different office bearers endorsing the claim of two different persons to be the competent Authority for the Common Entrance Test.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid Association to submit a certified copy of resolutions appointing the Competent Authority to conduct CET/CAP-2015 for B.Ed. & M.Ed. course."

- a) In view of the above decision, Prof. G.L. Ainapure submitted copy of resolutions appointing Dr. Santuk Hambarde as Competent Authority to conduct CET/CAP-2015 for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses vide its letters dated 24th April 2015; Resolution Signed by Prof. G.L. Ainapure.
 - b) And also Dr. Shaikh Ramzan has submitted copy of resolutions appointing Dr. Devendra Joshi as competent Authority to conduct CET/CAP-2015 for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses vide its letter dated 20th April 2015. Resolutions are verified and signed by Superintendent, Public Trusts Registration office, Aurangabad Region, Aurangabad.
- 3) Samiti in its Meeting held on 30th April 2015 vide Item no. 5 (i) decided as under_____

"Samiti went through copies of the resolutions appointing the Competent Authority for conduct of CET/CAP for B.Ed. and M.Ed. course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

Dr. S.Y. Chikhalikar Asso. Professor Govt. B.Ed. College, Mumbai on behalf of Director, Higher Education states that the rules for the admission process of B.Ed./M.Ed. Course are yet to be finalized by Government of Maharashtra.

Meanwhile Samiti decides to forward the brochure received by it, and also the subsequent letter sent by Dr. Shaikh Ramzan, Secretary dated 2nd March 2015 addressed to Pravesh Niyrantr Samiti for comments of the Director, Higher Education, Pune. After receipt, matter to be placed before Samiti for its consideration."

- 4) Association has submitted the Draft brochure related to conduct of CET/CAP – 15 for approval of Samiti vide its letter no. MVAMSA/B.Ed./M.Ed./2015/19 and MVAMSA/B.Ed./M.Ed./2015/20 dated 2/3/2015 Signed by Dr. Ramzan Shaikh, Secretary of the Association.
 - a) Office of the Pravesh Niyrantr Samiti has forwarded the same vide its letter no. PNS/2015-16/079 dated 13/5/2015 and letter no. प्रनिस/असो. /माहितीपुस्तिका/२०१५-१६/१७५७ दि. ८/६/२०१५ to Director, Higher Education, Pune.
 - b) Director, Higher Education, Pune has submitted his remarks vide letter under reference no. उंशिसं/ २०१४-१५/ प्रनिस/ नियमावलीतपासणी/ बीएड दि. १८/६/२०१५.

- 5) Samiti also perused letters no. MVAMSA PUNE/2015-16/38 dated 15/5/2015 signed by Shri. Ramkrishnapant Khoresekar and letter no. MVAMSA/B.Ed. & M.Ed./2015/070 dated 12/5/2015 signed by Dr. Shaikh Ramzan enclosed with Annexure – 3 [Rule 13(1)]
- 6) Samiti went through all the communication and the decisions it took herein before. After deliberations, Samiti decides to approve the draft brochure to conduct CET/CAP – 2015 for B.Ed. and M.Ed. course submitted by Dr. Ramzan Shaikh and appointing Dr. Devendra Joshi as a Competent Authority of ASSO. CET/CAP – 2015.

After deliberations, and in view of the guidance/interpretation received from Govt. of Maharashtra vide its letter quoted at Item no. 3 above, Samiti allows Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Aurangabad to conduct CET/CAP for B.Ed./M.Ed. course for Academic Year 2015-16.

Considering the suggestions of Expert Committee on said draft brochure submitted vide letter no. MVAMSA/B.Ed. & M.Ed./2015/079 dated 19/5/2015 signed by Dr. Shaikh Ramzan, Samiti directs as under__

- a) CET/CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and admission process to be on the basis of Merit.
- b) CET examinations should be conducted at the centers located in non related Colleges and staff for conduct of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non related faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) All admissions to be done as per the norms/rules/regulations/conditions laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble High Court, Respective Councils, Government of Maharashtra, Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti and University.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards/Result of CET-2015 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Aforesaid association should ensure that allotment of students to college is made strictly as per merit. Association should also ensure that colleges abide by the provisions of National council for Teacher Education (Guidelines for Regulation of Tuition fees & other fees chargeable by unaided Teacher Education Institutions) Amendment regulation 2010 duly published in Official Gazette-The Gazette of India, Extra ordinary, Part III, section-4 on 25th August 2010. It should be ensured that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days from the cut off date to Samiti's office.

- g) The Association monitoring and conducting CET/CAP should communicate to Samiti's office, the vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) The competent Authority will be the grievance redressal authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET/CAP examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to Samiti office from time to time.
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with their sanction intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after round.
 - v) List of selected candidates of each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and nature of action to taken on the complaints.
- j) Association should ensure that the permissions from Government of Maharashtra, Affiliations of Universities to the colleges are already in place in absence of which admissions done will not be approved by Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti.
- k) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners, their names, qualifications, etc. to Samiti immediately.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate the following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2015, as follows:-

- 1) The Rule of eligibility, Tie breaker, etc. is at par with MH-CET conducted by Director, Higher Education, Pune.
- 2) **Refund of Fees** : The Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow the following rule in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
 - i) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.

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- ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
- iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

Samiti further directs the Association to incorporate the changes and/or conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of CET-2015 of Maharashtra Vinaanudanit Adhyapak Mahavidyalay Sansthachalak Association, Aurangabad for admissions to B.Ed. and M.Ed. Course for Academic Year 2015-16.

Item No. 4 (b): Letter dated 10th June 2015 received from Director Technical Education Mumbai submitting remarks on Draft Brochure submitted by Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture, Pune (MASA) letter no. MASA/2014-15/15/202 dated 28/5/2015 for admission process of Academic Year 2015-16.

- 1) Samiti perused the remarks of Expert Committee Director, Technical Education, Mumbai M.S. appointed by the Samiti; vide letter no. २अ/एडीएम/२०१५/७९५ दिनांक १०/६/२०१५ on Draft Brochure submitted by Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture, Pune (MASA) letter no. MASA/2014-15/15/202 dated 28/5/2015 for admission process of Academic Year 2015-16.
- 2) Director Technical Education in his letter states that Government of Maharashtra has Published an ordinance dated 12th May 2015 vide no. VII of 2015, Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and fees) He further quotes that clause no. 2(b) and 2(c) providing for the Admission Process in Professional Educational Institutes which is to be conducted in transparent manner in single window system. He emphasizes that the Admission Process for B.Arch course needed to be conducted through Directorate of Technical Education as a competent Authority.
- 3) Dr. Rajeev Shetkar, Asst. Director, of Director, Technical Education, (MS) Mumbai pointed out that issue of Admission process of architecture courses for the Academic Year 2015-16 was subjudice.

After deliberation, in view of the fact that the matter is subjudice at present, Samiti feels that no action needs to be taken.

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Item No. 4 (c): Letters dated 28th April 2015 and Ref. No. B-348/2015 received from Degree College of Physical Education, Amaravati submitting Compliance there on Decision of the Samiti Meeting held on 27th March 2015 in respect of permission to conduct own/separate CET for B.P.Ed./ M.P.Ed. Courses for Academic Year 2015-16.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti went through the decision taken in the Meeting held on 27th March 2015 Item no. 4(c).

Samiti after deliberation, and in view of the guidelines/ interpretation received from Government of Maharashtra vide its letter quoted at Item no. 3 above decides to grant its permission to Hanuman Vyayam Prasarak Mandal's Degree College of Physical Education, Amravati to conduct their own admission process of B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. Courses in Aided and Unaided batch for AY 2015-16 and exempt them from CAP, since the said college is conducting their own admission process since long for more than 25 years or so.

Samiti allows Degree College of Physical Education to conduct CET for B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. Course for Academic Year 2015-16; and directs as under____

CET should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Councils, 4) Respective Universities, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra, 6) Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Maharashtra State and 7) Directorate of Higher Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.

- a) CET should be conducted at the centers located in non faculty Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non faculty.
- b) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- c) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi and National Council of Teacher Education, Bhopal (NCTE), if any.
- d) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards. Result of CET-2015 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- e) Institute should ensure that allotment of students to college is made strictly as per merit. Institute should submit the list of admissions within two days from the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- f) Institute conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.

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- g) The Competent Authority of the Organisation and / or Representatives of Director, Higher Education, Maharashtra State, Pune will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Organisation should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- h) All admissions to be done on the basis of CET conducted by the Institute with the requisite mark.
- i) Organisation/College is directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- j) It should be ensured that the College is having all permissions, affiliations of the respective Authorities and/or Universities.
- k) Where seats are likely to be increased, Organisation to publish the details before hand in Local as well State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of Organisation and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- l) Organisation should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately.
- m) Samiti further directs the Organisation to submit the following information to office from time to time without fail:-
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each rounds before and after rounds.
 - iv) List of selected candidates of each round.
 - v) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.
- n) **Refund of Fees :** The College/Institute is directed to follow the following rule in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
- i) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.

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iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.
