**Item No. 1: To approve and confirm Minutes of the Meeting of Pravesh Niyran Samiti (Medical Education) held on Thursday, the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2015 in the Conference Hall office of the Regional Center, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Mumbai.**

**Item No. 2: To review action taken by office on decisions arrived at in the previous meetings.**

Samiti perused the action taken report on the decisions arrived at in its previous meeting held on Thursday, the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2015 details of which are as below:-

**Item No. 3: To discuss, decide and plan for the verification of admission process in Health Science Courses for the Academic Year 2015-16.**

Samiti perused the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Education Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and fees) Act, 2015 (Mah Act No. XXVIII of 2015)

After deliberation, Samiti resolves as under :

**A) For Medical & Dental (UG & PG), BASLP, B.P.TH., B.O.T.H.**

- i) Director, Medical Education and Research will check and verify the admissions done in private Medical & Dental (UG & PG), where the admissions have been granted through ASSO-CET/CAP process for First year Medical and Dental, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test, same are to be brought to the notice of Samiti.

- ii) Director, Medical Education and Research will check & verify the admissions done in Director, Medical Education and Research will check & verify the admissions done in private Medical & Dental (UG & PG), BASLP, B.P.TH., B.O.T.H. where the admissions done through institute level, vacancy against CAP minority quota and Admissions against NRI Quota Medical & Dental (UG & PG), BASLP, B.P.TH., B.O.T.H. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test , same are to be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- iii) Director, Medical Education and Research shall follow the procedure and schedule laid down in clause 5 of Act.

**B) For BAMS, BHMS, BUMS (UG & PG)**

- i) Director, Ayush will check & verify the admissions done in private BAMS, BHMS, BUMS (UG & PG) Colleges/Institutes through ASSO-CET/CAP. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple tests , same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- ii) Director, Ayush will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions done through institute level, vacancy against CAP minority quota and Admissions against NRI Quota BAMS, BHMS, BUMS (UG & PG), where the admissions are done in violation of triple tests , same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- iii) Director, Ayush shall follow the procedure of schedule laid down in clause 5 of Act.

**C) Schedule for Submission for online Admission details**

- i) All Colleges / Institutes shall submit admission approval Proposals to concerned Directorate within 15 days from the Cut -off date of admission.
- ii) Every Unaided Institutions shall submit such proposal certified by the concerned directorate to the Admission Regulatory Authority within two months from the date of such certificate.
- iii) In case of failure / non observance of due dates same to be brought to the notice of Admission Regulatory Authority for further actions.
- iv) All Colleges / Instittues shall submit the proposal for approval of admissions done in 15% NRI Quota before 30th November 2015.
- v) Proposal of admitted candidates in 15% NRI quota should be verified by the office and also checked by the Desk Officer and thereafter proposal should be place before the Samiti for its consideration in due course.

Office to inform accordingly and take necessary steps.



**Item No. 4: To consider and decide on letters/representations received from:-**

**Item No. 4(a): Reply dated 6<sup>th</sup> October 2015 received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental College in respect of the complaint dated 9/9/2015 received from Ms. Aashta Abhaykumar Shukla.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference. Noted.

**Item No. 4(b): Letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> October 2015 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra asking permission to admit the candidates from other than Asso-CET-2015 for the First Year B.A.M.S. Course for the Academic Year 2015-16.**

Samiti perused aforesaid letter received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra asking permission to admit students from other than Asso-CET-2015 for admission to First Year B.A.M.S. Course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

After deliberation, Samiti accede to the request made by colleges to admit the students from other CET i.e. MH-CET-2015 and ASSO-CET-2015 for the admissions of first year B.A.M.S. course for Academic Year 2015-16. Samiti further decides that the approval of such students will be given only after submission of sufficient evidence as to the list of qualified students in ASSO-CET-2015 having been exhausted fully for Academic Year 2015-16 for First Year B.A.M.S. course by the Competent authority, Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical & Dental Colleges of Maharashtra before the admission. Office to inform accordingly.

**Item No. 4(c): Letter dated 14<sup>th</sup> October 2015 received from M.C.E. Society's M.A. Rangoonwala Dental College, Pune asking permission for Institute Level Entrance Test for the admission of Post Graduate Dental Courses for the Academic Year 2016-17.**

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from M.C.E. Society's M.A. Rangoonwala Dental College, Pune regarding permission for Institute level Entrance Test for the admission of Post Graduate Dental Courses for the Academic Year 2016-17.

Samiti also went through the Maharashtra Act No. XXVIII of 2015, dated 12<sup>th</sup> August 2015 – Chapter I clause (2) sub clause (m), which as under:-

(m) "Minority Educational Institution" means a Private Professional Educational Institution notified as such by the State Government, established and administered for and by the State Government, established and administered for and by the persons belonging to the minority community,

*domiciled in the State of Maharashtra, having right to do so under clause (1) of article 30 of the constitution of India;*

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti directs the aforesaid College/Institute to submit the relevant documents as prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra in Act No. XXVIII of 2015, dated 12<sup>th</sup> August 2015 as above. Office to inform accordingly.

**Item No. 4(d): Letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> October 2015 received from Post Graduate Institute of Swasthiyog Pratishthan, Miraj in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2015 (at Item No. 7[b]) submitted the copy of advertisement which published in Newspaper.**

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from Post Graduate Institute of Swasthiyog Pratishthan, Miraj in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2015 regarding approval of admission of admitted candidate viz. – Dr. Arun Kumar on the basis of AICET-2014 for the Post Graduate Diploma course for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti went through the decision taken by the Samiti in its meetings held on i) 4<sup>th</sup> July 2014 (at Item No. 8[b]), ii) 12<sup>th</sup> December 2015 (at Item No. 8[e]), iii) 11<sup>th</sup> August 2015 (at item No. 9[d]) and 29<sup>th</sup> September 2015 (at Item No. 7[b]).

Aforesaid College/Institute in its affidavit dated 29<sup>th</sup> June 2015 has stated that :-

*"merit has not been compromised and no injustice has been done to any of the candidates and none of the meritorious student was denied admission and no candidate has filed any complaint to any authority against the College for Post Graduate Admission process in the Academic Year 2014-15".*

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti decides to approve the admission of Arun Kumar admitted in Post Graduate Diploma Course in Academic Year 2014-15, subject of fulfillment of rules, regulation, norms and eligibility criteria laid down by the respective authorities. Office to inform.

**Item No. 5: To review - admissions in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15. (Ref.: As per the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2013 (at Item No. 9[a]).**
